From the year 2009-10, rural water supply is carried out as per the new policy of GOI i.e. National Rural Drinking Water Program (NRDWP). The goal of the program is to provide every individual in rural area with adequate water for drinking, cooking and other domestic basic needs on a sustainable basic. This basic requirement should meet certain minimum water quality standards and be readily and conveniently accessible at all times and in all situations. There is a paradigm shift in measuring coverage from the conventional trend in terms of liters per capita per day norms to ensure drinking water security for all in the community. To meet the emerging challenges in the rural drinking water sector relating to availability, sustainability and quality the components under the program are NRDWP(coverage), NRDWP (Sustainability), NRDWP (Water quality),
